

Baptistry Pump and Waterfall

The baptistry pump and waterfall are controlled by a **digital timer** and a **manual switch timer**.

Digital Timer (Scheduled)



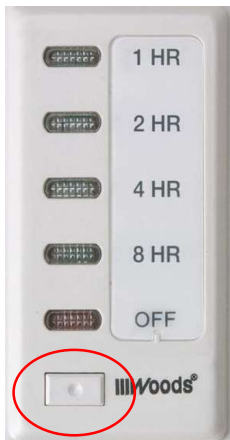
The digital timer is set up to control the pump and waterfall on a controlled scheduled basis.

Program A Zone 1 turns on the pump / filter on a daily basis (except Sundays) for four hours.

Program B Zones 2 and 3 turn on both the pump/filter and the waterfall for periods where the auditorium is used on a regular basis, such as Sunday worship services.

The normal switch position is “Run”. Setting the switch to “System Off” will disable the scheduled filter and waterfall run times.

Manual Switch Timer (On Demand)



The manual switch timer can be used to quickly and easily turn on both the **pump and waterfall** features for one-time periods not programmed into the digital timer. Simply press the button at the bottom, setting the timer for 1, 2, 4, or 8 hours. The timer will automatically turn off the pump and waterfall at the end of the provided time.
